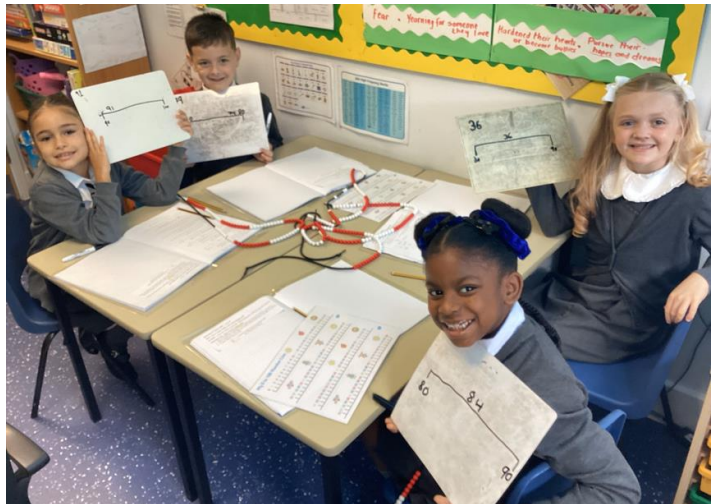


Thomas Class Autumn 1 Summary

Maths

In maths, we looked at various different topics including place value, graphs and number sense.
